

WYE VALLEY PHOTOGRAPHY WORKSHOP Saturday 23rd March 2019

The aim is to develop your understanding of composition in landscape photography and fully explore the creative potential of your camera to enable you to take technically excellent and creative images in a variety of locations and lighting conditions

6.00 am - DAWN START AT SYMONDS YAT ROCK (OPTIONAL)

Symonds Yat Rock offers superb views down the Wye Valley and is at its best at dawn, It's an easy walk from the car park We'll be up here at dawn or if the dawn start doesn't go ahead, here from 10am

3 Tintern Abbey and the Wye (may include.lunch outside) 11.30 am - 1.00 pm

There are great views of Tintern Abbey from the surrounding area and views down the river. We explore the area and the abbey itself

4 Chepstow Town and Castle (may include review session over lunch)

We spend the early afteroon in Chepstow, photographing the Castle and with a composition exercise in the town and go to Sudbury to view the original Severn Bridge. If the light is looking good we will include the review session over lunch instead of in the evening.

5 Severn Bridge at Sunset 5.00 - 6.30pm approx & finish

We cross the Severn Bridge to capture the new bridge at sunset from New Passage

6 Post Processing Session - lunchtime or end of day depending on weather / light

We return to Chepstow for a review & post processing session either at lunchtime or around 5pm. The option we go for will depend on weather conditions.
